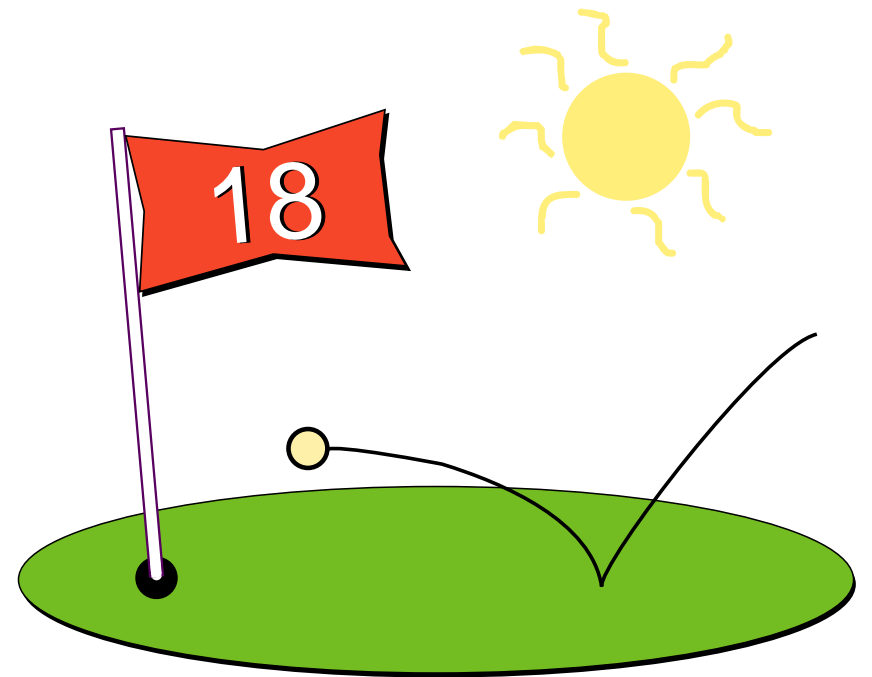

Welcome to the 2007 18 Hole Golf season at Maryland Golf and Country Club. We invite you to participate in as many weekly events as possible and we encourage you to sign up for all the tournaments and activities offered by the 18 Hole Ladies.

Please read the following rules and guidelines for the 18 Hole Ladies Group.

Dues

Our \$40 dues will be distributed into two funds-\$38 will go into the general fund and \$2 will go to the Sunshine fund.

Hole in One

A Hole in One made at Maryland Golf and Country Club by a member of the 18 Hole Ladies Group will be recognized whenever it is made-not limited to Thursday play day. Any member contributing \$2 has the option to be in the Hole in One Club. The money will be collected and overseen by the Hole in One Chairperson. The Chairperson will also be responsible for ensuring the fund is replenished after a winner depletes the fund. The winner has the option of deciding to accept the money in the fund or a plaque commemorating the event plus any money left over from having the plaque made.

18 Hole Tees

All play on 18 Hole play days will be from the silver tees.

Points and Sweepstakes

To be eligible, members must pay sweeps money each play day of \$1.00 and finish all holes without picking up. Players must have 10 scores during the season to qualify to receive money at the end of the season. Sweeps are awarded to A, B, and C groups. Players are not eligible for sweeps, low gross or low net if they pick up on any hole.

Attendance Points

If a player picks up on no more than 3 holes she will receive an attendance point.

Maximum strokes for X-Out holes

The player may take the maximum stroke total for a hole according to her handicap if she picks up.

Sign Up

Sign up for all play days and all tournaments needing specific sign ups will be in the ladies locker room. Check to confirm whether you are responsible for signing up weekly for a tournament.

Tee Times

April tee times will begin at 9:00 am: May tee times will start at 8:30 am: and June tee times will start at 8:00am. Tee times will return to 9:00 am in October. If you need a late tee time due to school bus or other obligations, please notify the pro shop and they will accommodate your needs.

Tournament Sign-up

Sign ups will be on the posted tournament sheet. You are responsible for signing up each week for the President's Cup tournament. Some tournaments such as the Member/Member are team number sensitive and will have cut-off numbers.

Most Improved Award

Presented to the player at the end of the year who has achieved the highest percentage improvement for the season. Player must have played 12 times on our regularly scheduled play day to be eligible.

Mid-Season Improvement Award

Award presented to the player who has received the highest percentage of improvement by mid-season. Mid season cut-off is 7/19.

Rain Cancellation Policy

If the course is open and 8 players show up to play it counts as a play day.

Birdies and Ringers during Tournaments and Scrambles

If a player has played her own ball from tee to hole in stroke play without improving her lie, the birdie and /or ringer can be recorded. During scrambles, birdies and ringers cannot be recorded.

Posting Scores

Members of MGCC are required to post all scores whether they are on regular play day or for casual play rounds in accordance with the "USGA Rules of Golf". Players are also required to post 9 Hole scores.

- 13 or more holes played, post an 18 hole score
- 7-12 holes played, post a 9 hole score

Post your own score in the computer. Turn your scorecard into the Pro Shop after play. (On ladies 18-hole play day players are to place their scorecards in 18-hole box in locker room after checking ringers) On the scorecard include the first and last name and circle the tees played.

Ringers

Three prizes will be awarded at the end of the year for ringers in the A, B, and C groups. Each player will be assigned a group at the beginning of the season, determined by handicap. For prize purposes only, the player will remain in that group throughout the playing season. For playing purposes, a player may move in and out of the groups as her handicap increases or decreases.

Fall Tournament

No Qualifying-Three weeks of match play with no handicap. Players will be placed in flights according to their handicap as of the first of September.

WEEKLY TOURNAMENTS AND SPECIAL EVENTS

A-B-C Scramble

Each threesome consists of an A,B,&C player. All golfers tee off, pick the best drive. Each golfer then drops and hits from that spot; continue to pick the best ball doing the same until the ball is holed out. All balls may be placed in the fairway, rough, and sand traps within one club length, no closer to the hole of the spot selected.

Tin Whistle Tournament

Each player receives a point on her net score as follows:

- Net Bogey-1 point
- Net Par-3 points
- Net Birdie-5 points
- Net Eagle-7 Points
- Hole in One-10 points

The Skins Game

Player with the best net score wins hole. If two or three players tie on a hole, a “push” occurs. Player winning the next hole is credited with previous pushed holes. If tie occurs after 18, tying players continue until “sudden death”.

Beat the Pro

Each player plays against the Pro. Winner of Spring Handicap and previous Fall Tournament will play with the Pro.

Florida Scramble

The tournament is played as a three-person team. On Par 3's every player plays her own ball and the total of the three scores is counted. On Par 4's every player tees off and the best shot is chosen. All players move up to that best shot and continue to play their own ball into the hole; total of two scores is counted. On Par 5's every player tees off and best shot is chosen. All players hit again from that spot and again the best shot is chosen. All players move to the 2nd best shot and continue playing their own ball into the hole; the total of 1 score is counted.

Criss Cross

Record the best net score for either hole 1 or 10, hole 2 or 11, hole 3 or 12, etc.

T & F Holes

Each player plays 18 holes and only scores the holes that start with a "T" (two, three, ten, twelve and thirteen) and the holes that start with an "F" (four, five, fourteen and fifteen).

Throw Out Two Worst Holes

Each player plays 18 holes and counts her net for each hole on scorecard. Each player selects two holes to throw out and records the 16 hole score.

Member-Guest

Rain or Shine! Invite a guest to play golf, compete for prizes and enjoy Lunch on Thursday June 14th. Guest may not be a member of MGCC. Play may be in foursomes of your own choosing. Must inform Pro Shop of guest index prior to tournament. Guests are required to hand in five scorecards to establish handicap and if they do not have an index, they will be assigned an index of 15 or a handicap of 18.

Charity Tournament

Open to members of MGCC and guests-not just 18 Hole members. Play will be in foursomes. Prizes and Luncheon follow play. All proceeds will benefit charities selected by the 18 Hole members.

WOMEN'S 18-HOLE INTERCLUB ASSOCIATION

Eligibility

Women must have a 34.9 handicap index or lower and be an active member of the 18 Hole Ladies Group. If your handicap goes up during the season, you are still eligible to finish the season.

Sign Up

Members will sign up if they can play and the 9 lowest handicap players will compete; two alternates may also play. The others will be on a waiting list if someone cancels. Please include member number on the sign-up sheet for billing purposes.

Play Day Costs

At most clubs the cost of lunch and carts is billed back to your MGCC account. A few clubs require payment on the play day; that information will be noted on the sign-up sheet. We do encourage golfers to stay for lunch, as this is a social day. No refunds will be given after the team is posted.

There is an initial \$15.00 fee to join interclub. Team shirts can be purchased at the Pro Shop.

Scoring

Interclub players will play with full handicap. The team competition will be played by up to 9 golfers. Points will be awarded individually for each match. There will be an individual championship at the end of the season for the two golfers from each club with the most points for the individual championship.
